

# Check List for Your Manuscript

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1. There should be only one sentence in the title of the manuscript.		
2. The title should be a declarative sentence. There should be <b>no end marks</b> in the title of the manuscript, For example: question mark “?”		
3. The title of the manuscript should be no less than 3 words and no more than 25 words.		
4. Please capitalize the first letter in each word of the title, except the function words or proper nouns.		
<b>For example:</b> Nurture in Technological Innovation and Social Responsibility		
The Name of the Author	√	×
1. The name of the author should be written in English.		
2. Titles are not included in the name of the author. Such as: <del>Dr.</del> Prof.		
3. Please write the authors’ <b>full names</b> . There should not be only one word in the name of the author. If the authors’ names are special, please inform us (especially for the capital and small letter, or comma among the names).		
4. There should be no comma in the name of one author. For example: A., Wilson (The comma will be deleted.)		

5. There should be a period in the abbreviated form of the name. For example: <u>A.</u> Wilson		
6. Please capitalize the first letter in the name of the author. For example: <u>A</u> frin <u>W</u> ilson		
7. Please check and confirm the name(s) of the author(s).		
<b>For example:</b> Levon Wilson <sup>1</sup> , Silva Wilson <sup>2,*</sup>		
<b>The Affiliation of the Author</b> <span style="float: right;">✓ ×</span>		
1. The affiliation of the author should include department/faculty, university/institute, city and nation. (There should be <b>no PO Box, postcode, telephone, fax or road</b> in the affiliation of the author.)		
2. The affiliation of the author should be written in English.		
3. The affiliation of the author should not be in the abbreviated form.		
4. There should be no profession title in the affiliation of the author. Such as: <del>Doctør</del> , <del>Professor</del> .		
5. Please check and confirm the names of the authors and the corresponding affiliations.		
<b>Such as:</b> <sup>1</sup> Polytechnic Institute, New York University, New York, USA <sup>2</sup> Department of Biological Sciences, University of North Texas, Denton, USA		
<b>Email Address</b> <span style="float: right;">✓ ×</span>		
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3. One email address should be only attached to one author.		
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<b>Such as:</b> afrin.wil@xxxxxx.edu (Afrin Wilson)		
<b>Abstract</b> <span style="float: right;">✓ ×</span>		
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<p><b>For example:</b></p> <p><b>Abstract</b></p> <p>The abstract is an independent essay which introduces the topic of the manuscript. It generally includes the research objective, the research method, the research analysis, the research results, the research conclusion, etc. An excellent abstract should give prominence to the innovative results of the research, have clear conclusion, avoid the repetition of content and give the full name of the abbreviations at the first time, which makes the manuscript easy to understand.</p>		
<p><b>Keywords</b> <span style="float: right;">✓ ×</span></p>		
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<p><b>For example:</b> Monetary Policy, Dhaka Stock Exchange (DSE), Stock Return</p>		
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<p>1. The manuscript that meets the standard of publication should have at least three parts.</p> <p>For example:</p> <p>1.Introduction</p> <p>2.XXXXXX(the detailed contents of the paper)</p> <p>3.Conclusion</p>		
2. Please add the numbers from the first part of the manuscript. The first part should be numbered as "1. Introduction".



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1. A caption should be given to each figure and be placed immediately beneath its figure.		
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manuscript using the single-number system. Such as: Figure 1, Figure 2, Figure 3...		
4. The number of the figures should be unified. Such as: Figure 1, Figure 2, Figure 3... (Or Fig. 1, Fig. 2, Fig. 3...). <b>Don't use fig. 1, Figure 2, fig. 1.</b>		
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7. The words in the figures should be written in English.		
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<b>Formulas</b>		
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4. There should be <b>no messy code</b> in the formulas.		
<b>Such as:</b>		
$\sigma_{Ki} = \frac{N_{Ki}}{I_0 G \varepsilon_{Ki} \beta t} \quad (1)$		
$\beta = \frac{1 - \exp[-(\mu_1 / \sin \theta + \mu_2 / \sin \theta)t]}{(\mu_1 / \sin \theta + \mu_2 / \sin \theta)t} \quad (2)$		
<b>Biography</b>		
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2. The author's biography should be no more than 100 words.		
<b>Such as:</b>
